- E. Pastor's Report
  - 1. Diocesan bankruptcy process update: Discussions are ongoing regarding financial responsibility our parish will face to receive protection against future claims of past incidents similar to the protection the diocese seeks. Bar date for claims against diocese has passed.

    - a. Qualitative: Survey parishioners regarding their needs and wants, analyzing and putting the feedback into practice and repeating survey.
    - b. Quantitative: Mass attendance, collection totals.
