

Employee pay raises


The case for employee pay raises

- Unlike most other parishes, we conduct annual employee evaluations
 - 1. Objective (quantitative)
 - 2. Subjective (qualitative) with input from supervisor and pastoral or finance council
 - 3. Self-evaluation
- NB. Clergy pay is dictated by the diocese


Physical Plant


PROPOSED RAMP LAYOUT

- Parish Center renovated last summer
- Organ will be installed in the choir loft in June
- Morgan Hall bathrooms will be renovated this summer

Pastoral Update

Update: Results-based Management

- Reviews received to date
 - 32 event reviews (since May 2022)
 - 8 wedding reviews (33% response rate)
 - 49 baptism reviews (30% response rate)
- Staff and pastoral council members have access to above reviews
- Religious Ed Office will soon send its second annual parent survey
- Full implementation requires a cultural change

Update: Sunday First

- Since last year's meeting, we hired Bob Tulini as Coordinator of Liturgy
 - Goal is not only a smooth liturgy; it's an improved liturgical experience
- This principle takes on greater importance in the year ahead, which is the parish phase of the US Church's three-year Eucharistic Revival
 - A small group is meeting tomorrow to write the parish's plan for this effort
- Unfortunately, the Mass schedule is under threat from a diocesan "right-sizing" effort
 - We are supposed to permanently eliminate a Mass by July

Curriculum-based ministries

- Curriculum-based
 - Provided by outside organization
- Demographic-based
 - Limited by age and sex
- Generally follow large group / small group format
 - Large group presentation
 - Small group discussion

Women	Walking with Purpose
Men	That Man is You
Girls	Blaze
Boys	Ignite

Small Christian Communities

- Also known as faith sharing groups
- They are small groups of parishioners often meeting weekly in homes to share the faith in light of their personal circumstances
- Msgr. Morgan promoted them under the umbrella of RENEW
- A few still meet
- Last year, a few parishioners suggested we relaunch these groups

Small Christian Communities

- Goals
 - **☆**Five groups

 - \$\times 40 parishioners (8 per group)
- Discuss Sunday readings with questions and helpful context provided by team
- Staff point person: Veronica Spilker

May	Invite parishioners to be facilitators
Summer	Team finalizes content
September	Groups are promoted and opened for signupsFacilitator training
October and November	Small groups are meeting
Late November	Evaluation

Small Christian Communities

- The curriculum-based ministries are faith-sharing groups
- The relaunching of SCC's is meant to cast a wider net than WWP and TMIY, not compete with them
