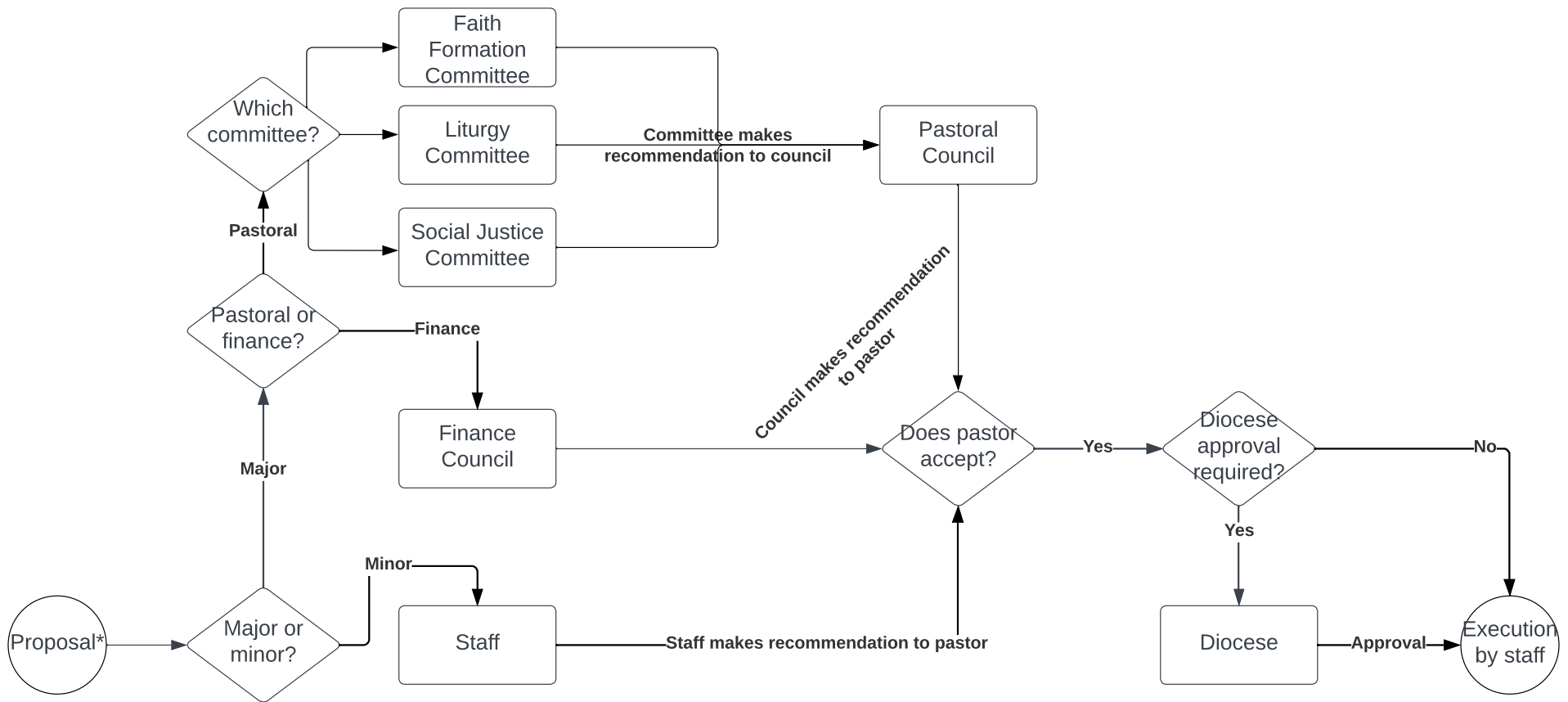


How a Proposal is Considered



* Parishioners or staff make a proposal to the pastor or the pastor himself has a proposal. Proposals are best made through event feedback using the parish website, at the annual discernment meeting, or by letter or email. Verbal comments are easily forgotten or misremembered.

Parishioners can also make proposals directly to a pastoral council committee. Members of both councils can ask their chair to put a proposal on the agenda.
